SPECIAL TOWN MEETING NOVEMBER 18, 2019

On a motion by Paden, seconded by Tim Curtin, the electors voted to adopt the proposed 2019 tax levy of 237,262, to be collected and paid in 2020, pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of WI Statutes. Motion approved and carried by the town electors. Passed unanimously.

Special meeting for adopting of Budget. Chairman called to order. Proposed budget for 2020 of \$472,366. Motion by Curtin to accept budget. Paden 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. With no further business, a motion was made by Dana Shultz, to close the special town meeting. Tim Curtin 2nd. Adjourned the meeting at 5:38 P.M.
